FRANTIC ASSEMBLY APPOINTS KERRY WHELAN AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Internationally renowned theatre company **Frantic Assembly** has appointed **Kerry Whelan** as Executive Director and Joint Chief Executive. Whelan joins Frantic Assembly from BalletBoyz Ltd and will take up his post in January 2018, working together with Artistic Director and co-founder Scott Graham to bring the company's ambitious plans for the future to fruition.

With over twenty-five years' experience in the cultural and creative industries, Whelan has worked as a venue manager, programmer, arts funder, producer, consultant and advisor.

Since 2006 Whelan has been Executive Director of BalletBoyz Ltd overseeing a four-fold increase in company turnover, two consecutive Arts Council England funding uplifts and a major capital project to create the company's own studio base. In 2013 BalletBoyz was named Best Independent Company at the National Dance Awards. He produced a huge range of projects in theatre and film including UK and international tours, seasons at Sadler's Wells, The Royal Festival Hall and the Royal Opera House and films for the BBC, Channel 4 and Sky Arts including the ground-breaking WW1 set feature film, *Young Men*, which won Rose D'Or and Golden Prague awards in 2017.

Kerry Whelan said, "I am thrilled to be joining Frantic Assembly, having long admired its brave and ground-breaking work. Through its stage productions, education offering and training programmes the company has become synonymous with collaborative, original, diverse and inclusive activity. I look forward to carrying on that work with Scott, the Trustees and fantastic staff team and to developing new projects and opportunities."

Frantic Assembly's Artistic Director Scott Graham said, "I have always been impressed by Kerry and I am absolutely thrilled that we get to bring that drive and vision into the Frantic Assembly team. These are exciting times for the company and I can't wait for us to get started!"

Frantic Assembly's Chair Sian Alexander said, "We are thrilled to appoint Kerry Whelan as Executive Director and Joint Chief Executive alongside Scott Graham. Kerry brings exceptional leadership skills as well as extensive experience of enabling bold and ambitious creative work. We are excited for the future of Frantic Assembly under their joint leadership."

In 2018 Frantic Assembly will present *Fatherland*, a bold, ambitious show about contemporary fatherhood in all its complexities and contradictions. Created by Frantic Assembly's Scott Graham, Karl Hyde from Underworld and playwright Simon Stephens (*Punk Rock, The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time*), this daring collage of words, music and movement will transform the Lyric Hammersmith (25 May – 23 June), animated by a 13-strong cast and a multitude of voices.

2018 will also see the second UK tour of *Things I Know To Be True*, an international coproduction with State Theatre Company South Australia, play its final two dates. Returning to the Lyric Hammersmith (11 Jan - 3 Feb), where Andrew Bovell's play had its UK premiere during its first UK tour in 2016, *Things I Know To Be True* will also play Bristol Old Vic (6-10 Feb).

Award winning theatre company Frantic Assembly's method of devising theatre has been impacting theatrical practice and unlocking the creative potential of future theatre-makers for 23 years. One of the most exciting theatre companies in the UK, Frantic Assembly is led by Artistic Director and co-founder Scott Graham, and has toured extensively across Great Britain, and worked in over 40 countries internationally collaborating with some of today's most inspiring artists.

Frantic Assembly is currently studied as leading contemporary theatre practitioners on five British and international academic syllabuses. The success of the company's distinct approach has influenced contemporary theatre-making and foregrounded the use of movement directors and choreographers in new dramatic works. With a history of commissioning writers such as Mark Ravenhill, Abi Morgan, Simon Stephens and Bryony Lavery the company has been acclaimed for it's collaborative approach. In 2016 the company started delivering practical modules on a new Collaborative Theatre-Making MA it has created with Coventry University (UK Modern University of the Year 2014, 2015, 2016 and UK University of the Year 2015). Frantic Assembly runs Ignition, a free national training programme for young men aged 16-20, increasing involvement in and access to the arts in places of low cultural engagement.

Frantic Assembly productions include Fatherland, Things I Know To Be True (UK and Australia), Othello, Beautiful Burnout (UK, Australia, New Zealand and New York), Lovesong, Stockholm (UK and Australia), The Believers. They are also the Movement Directors on the award-winning National Theatre of Great Britain, production The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time (West End, Broadway, UK & Ireland Tour, US Tour. International Tour). Television credits include Movement Direction on BAFTA winning British - American series Humans (AMC, Channel 4 & Kudos).
